## Safety Instructions for Driving the Vehicles of ISAK Ltd. in Iceland.

### In Emergency: Call 112

We at ISAK Ltd. are concerned about your safety and well-being. Therefore we would like to provide you with the following instructions:

1. **Icelandic gravel roads can be tricky**, especially the loose gravel on the shoulders and when changing over from the paved roads. Show extra care while getting used to gravel roads, and reduce speed when passing vehicles from opposite direction to avoid stone chipping and broken windshields.
2. **Passengers have to use safety belts** at all times and always drive with the lights on. Speed limits are max 90 km/h on paved roads, 80 km/h on gravel roads and mainly 50 km/h in towns.
3. Pay special attention to **single-lane bridges**, still to be found on many roads.
4. Where domestic **animals are at the road side**, show increased care, especially where 'mother and child' are on the opposite part of the road.
5. Due to swift changes in the weather **icy road conditions** can come up without warning, especially around freezing point. Show increased attention when ice crystals appear on the road, especially on tarmac. By such conditions wider tires slide more easily than normal ones.
6. When driving in a convoy, **keep also an eye on the Defender next behind you**. If you wish to have an unforeseen stop, like for photographing, do contact the guide.
7. In windy conditions, always **park the vehicle in to the wind** and have a firm grip of the door handle while opening doors.

8. Although often speaking of driving off road in Iceland, we **never leave the road** or the trail except in emergency. Normal trails can be considered challenging enough. Anyhow, driving on snow is accepted, as it doesn't leave any permanent tracks on the ground.
9. The fender extensions for **the big tires make the vehicle wider than you see**. Especially on the right side there's a blind corner. Be careful in narrow passages.
10. **Only those named and signed as drivers** on the first page of the car rental agreement **are authorized** to drive the vehicle. For driving these vehicles a driving license for a car and age of at least 21 years is required.
11. Please **follow the instructions of the guide at all times**. Not obeying these instructions can result in voiding the particular driver and the validity of the insurances. Be aware that the driver is liable for damage resulting from the use of the vehicle for which no compensation will be paid by the vehicle's insurance company, if not otherwise agreed. This includes damage to the automobile and/or injury to passengers due to the following:
  - driving across rivers or water course, not obeying the instructions of the guide,
  - off-road driving, not obeying the instructions of the guide,
  - intentional acts or gross negligence,
  - being under influence of intoxicants (e.g. alcohol and/or drugs) by the driver,
  - vehicle use that contravenes Icelandic law and/or the provisions of this lease.
12. **Driver and passengers are insured in the vehicle**, the collision damage waiver (CDW) is included. The own risk for a damage amounts to EUR 2.000,-. For further information on what the collision damage waiver does not cover, please see the appropriate items of article no. 21 on the reverse side of the Car Rental Agreement.
